

While the *primary* carrier fleet engagement occurred well to the north of Midway Atoll, much of the *secondary* action occurred within or originated from the atoll. Midway is a tiny, remote atoll which was, 75 years ago, one of the most strategically important few square miles of land in the world.

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service administers Midway today as Midway Atoll National Wildlife Refuge. The refuge lies within Papahānaumokuākea Marine National Monument, a marine protected area encompassing all of the Northwestern Hawaiian Islands. In 2000, The Secretary of the Interior designated Midway Atoll National Wildlife Refuge as the Battle of Midway National Memorial. This was the
